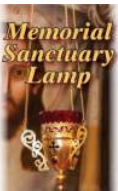

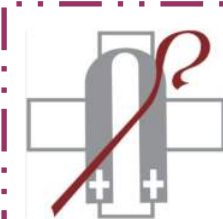

## THE 2024 MASS BOOK OPENED

We have maintained our policy regarding requests for Mass Intentions for 2024. Individuals may *initially* request ten (10) Masses, eight (8) weekdays and two (2) weekends (Saturday at 4 PM, Sunday at 8 AM and 10 AM,) January through June. Beginning November 29, 2023, you can request additional weekday Masses. When the second half of the year opens on April 8, 2024, an additional three (3) weekend Masses may be requested. Canon Law (543) states that a pastor is obliged to have one “Pro Populo” Mass (a Mass for the intentions of the people of his parish) each Sunday and each Holy Day of Obligation. At the Parish of St Michael the Archangel, this Mass is rotated through the weekend Masses. A \$15 stipend is due for each Mass intention and Sanctuary Candle intention.

## THE SEASON OF ADVENT



**Sunday, December 3, 2023 - Sunday, December 24, 2023**

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ’s second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord’s birth on Christmas. From the earliest days of the Church, people have been fascinated by Jesus’ promise to come back. But the scripture readings during Advent tell us not to waste our time with predictions. Advent is not about speculation. Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world (Lk 21:34-36). Like Lent, the liturgical color for Advent is purple since both are seasons that prepare us for great feast days. Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

Advent devotions including the Advent wreath, remind us of the meaning of the season. Our Advent calendar (<https://www.usccb.org/resources/Advent-Calendar-2023%20English.pdf>) can help you fully enter into the season with daily activity and prayer suggestions to prepare you spiritually for the birth of Jesus Christ.
