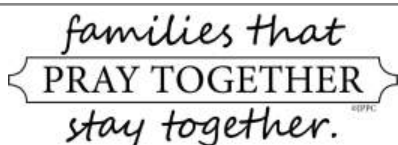
Red Eye

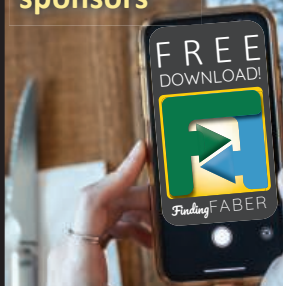
