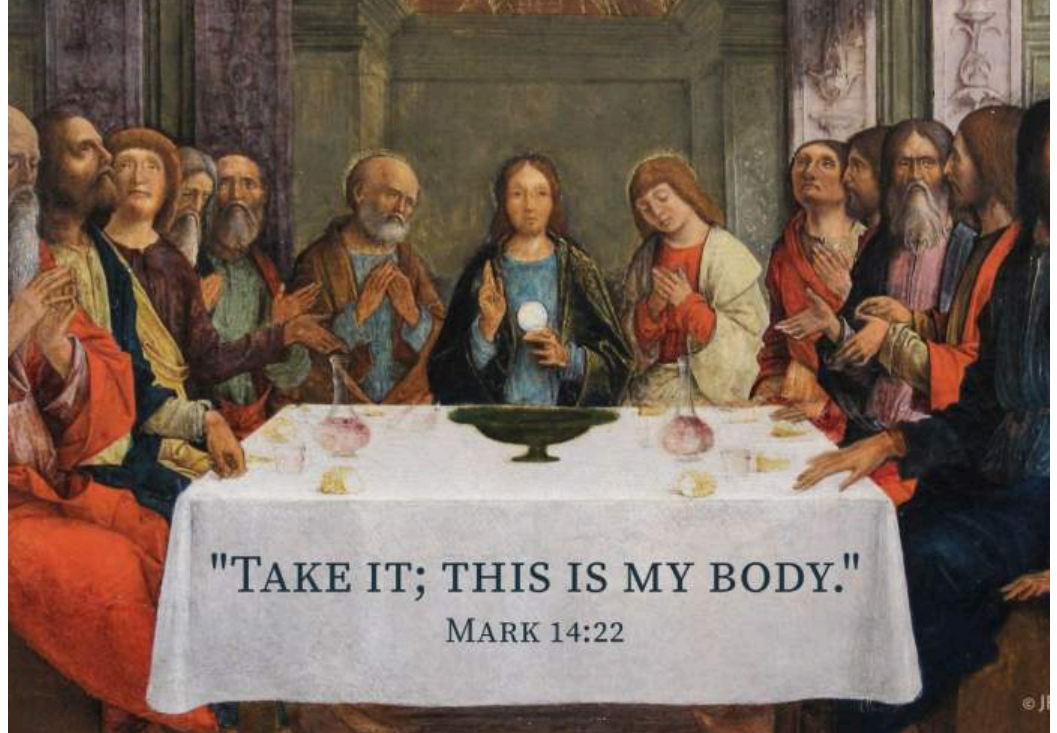

**Coadjutawhat?**

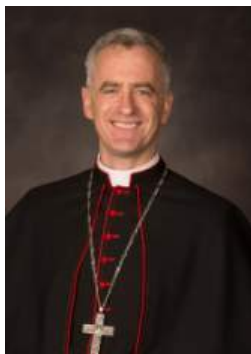

### NEWLY APPOINTED COADJUTOR BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN



Pope Francis announced the appointment of Bishop Joseph A. Williams as coadjutor bishop of the Diocese of Camden. A coadjutor bishop is appointed to assist the diocesan bishop until his retirement. Bishop Dennis J. Sullivan submitted his letter of resignation to the Holy Father, as required by Canon Law, on his 75th birthday, March 17, 2020. In honor of his faithful service to the people of New York and

Camden, Bishop Sullivan has been notified that his resignation will be accepted on his 80th birthday, March 17, 2025.
