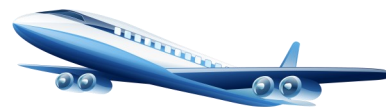

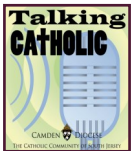
Ministry to the Homebound

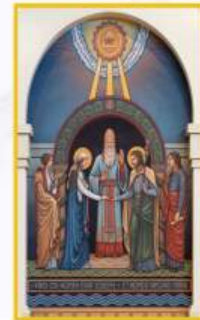
