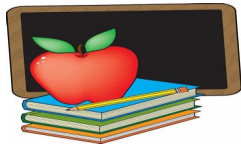

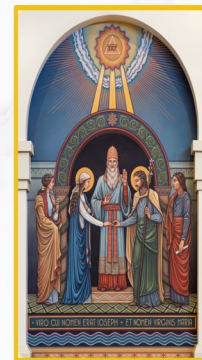
**RETROUVILLE: REDISCOVER THE LOVE IN YOUR
