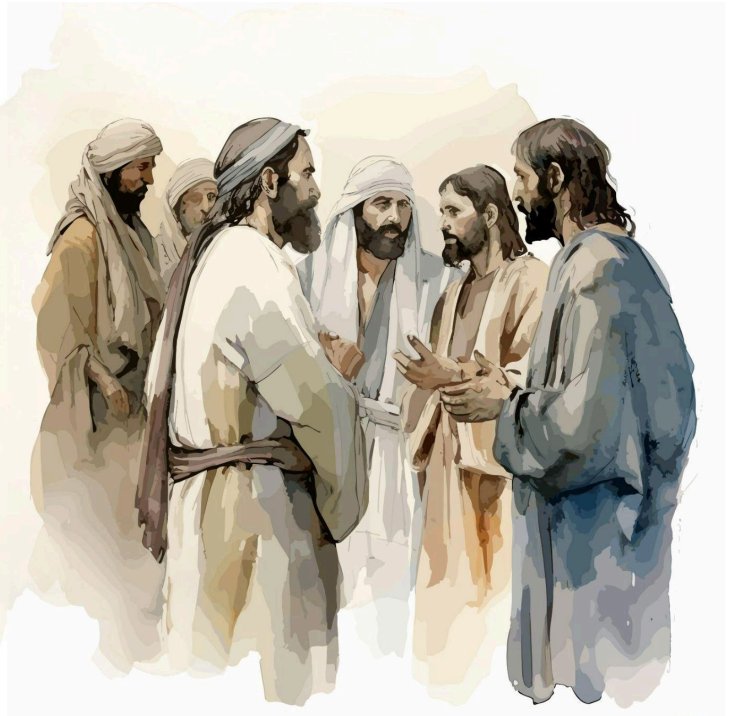

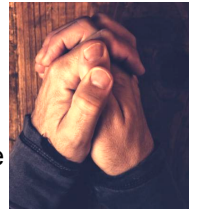

## WHAT IS YOUR DISCIPLESHIP JOURNEY?


